BAIC México is part of a global automotive group with Chinese origins and operations across multiple international markets. After more than ten years operating in Mexico through an importer, the company made a strategic decision in 2025 to establish a direct local operation. The objective was clear: strengthen control over growth, build closer relationships with dealers and customers, and align local activities with the organization's global standards. This transition represented much more than a market expansion. It marked the beginning of a new stage focused on long term consolidation in one of the most important automotive markets in Latin America.

Today, BAIC México combines local professionals with expatriate talent, creating a team that blends deep market knowledge with international expertise. The operation supports key business functions including Sales, Marketing, After Sales, Logistics, Finance, Legal, and Human Resources, while coordinating a growing national dealer network. In a structure of this scale and complexity, operational consistency and internal control are fundamental elements for sustainable growth.



What challenges were they facing with payroll?

Launching a direct operation in Mexico brought one of the most important challenges any international company can face: building a payroll structure from the ground up within a highly regulated environment. The objective was not simply to process payroll accurately. BAIC México needed to ensure full compliance with local authorities including SAT, IMSS, and INFONAVIT while maintaining complete visibility and traceability throughout every payroll cycle. The situation became even more complex due to the integration of expatriate employees and the requirement to align local payroll processes with global corporate standards. Every procedure needed to be clearly defined, documented, and executed consistently. During a period of organizational consolidation, any payroll error could create financial, legal, or reputational risks.
